1. OSM Regeneration Working Group.

Although the summer is not the best time to progress with our projects many things were achieved. The Town Clerk has kindly sent you some of the documents mentioned in the following list:

- An editorial to be published in the Gazette under the title: “Ottery Road to Regeneration Starts Here” which has been received very well and has generated requests from members of the public to join the sub-working groups. This will be considered at the next meeting of the Town Centre Management sub-group.
- An update of the flow charts created by Dave Moss has been published on the Regeneration page of the Council website.
- The Regeneration page on the Council website has been updated. Many thanks to Liz and Sue for their help. We will continue working on it as things progress.
- Talks and negotiations with EDDC and DCC have continued in a very positive way and we hope to have a more extensive report by the next Council meeting.
- Now that the Town Centre Management sub-Group is progressing rapidly with its objectives we are of the thought that the Heritage and Conservation sub-Group should be initiated. Talks with the Heritage Society and with possible invited members to the sub-group are on the pipeline.
- Initial talks with King’s have taken place in order to initiate a project that will allow young people to express the way they see regeneration. These talks will continue after the students return to school in September.
