

Anyone wishing to contact the police, in a non-emergency should follow these simple steps to ensure they get the help they need:

How to contact the police:

**1. Are you wanting to report a breach of Covid 19 restrictions?**

If you are reporting a breach of restrictions then you can do this using the national reporting form on the Police.uk website - [www.police.uk](http://www.police.uk)

**2. AskNED – the non-emergency directory**

Need to ask a question but not sure who to ask for help, then AskNED - [dc.police.uk/AskNED](http://dc.police.uk/AskNED)

**3. Go online – [dc.police.uk](http://dc.police.uk)**

On the Forces website you can find the answers to many of the questions people ask when calling the police plus lots of helpful information and advice.

**4. Report Crime Online**

If you need to report a crime or tell the police something, then why not report online using WebChat or the Crime Reporting Form - [dc.police.uk](http://dc.police.uk)

**5. Call - 101 – The national non-emergency number**
