- 3. For those who have no visual access to the meeting, Members will state their name before speaking and voting.
- 4. For those who are unable to hear, the agendas and the minutes of the meeting will be available on the Councils website.

Recording of Meetings etc - This meeting is being audio recorded by the Council and the recording will subsequently be available for public listening on request. Under the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014, any members of the public are allowed to take photographs, film and audio record the proceedings and report on all public meetings (including on social media). - 1. To receive apologies for absence
- 2. To receive Declarations of interest for items on the Agenda and receipt of requests for new Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPIs) dispensations for items on the Agenda
- 3. In consideration of the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 (publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest by reason of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted): to agree any items to be dealt with after the public and press have been excluded
- 4. To consider any Reports, Correspondence and make recommendations (if appropriate) in respect of the regeneration of the town
- 5. To further consider professional consultation in regards to various larger regeneration projects under consideration.
- 6. To further review and action projects previously voted on at the Full Council Meeting of Monday 3rd August 2020 and signed off ready to implement.
- 7. To discuss the possibility to provide further car parking specifically to identify land that we may be able to secure or that is already available for this purpose.
- 8. To further discuss ways of active commuting and the extension of cycling, walking and running routes in and around town.
- 9. Further to the meeting of July 2020 the need to investigate the possibility of being able to implement a speed limit of 20 mph throughout some of the roads of Ottery St Mary, up to and including Ottery Nurseries. Consideration to be given to what permissions are to be sought and to make decisions as to whether this is realistic to deliver.

- 10. General discussion of all other points at the July 2020 meeting. The main objective is to compile a priority list of which projects are to be moved forward and obtain costings and permissions for these projects.
- 11. Consideration of smaller projects that we may be able to consider in the short term to enhance the town and improve facilities for residents of the parish.
- 12. To clarify joint project overlap with Greener Ottery Transport group and to identify priorities.
