TO CONSIDER A RESPONSE TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT SITES IN THE EDDC EMERGING LOCAL PLAN

It was explained that land owners have put forward sites throughout East Devon for possible inclusion in the EDDC Emerging Local Plan. These sites are being reviewed by the EDDC Strategic Planning Committee. The purpose of this meeting is to gather the views of members of the public and councillors in relation to each of the sites proposed in Ottery St Mary. Despite Ottery St Mary increasing by 25% (700 houses) over the past 10 years the Council are concerned that other East Devon towns which have stronger transport links with a railway station and better bus service have less proposed development in their areas. There has not been adequate investment in the infrastructure to support the increase in growth that has already taken place and it was noted that outlying villages such as West Hill, Tipton St John and Alfington all use the Ottery facilities. There is currently a shortage of primary school and secondary school places, and the doctor's surgery is struggling to meet demand. All the sites proposed in Ottery St Mary are greenfield sites. The Council strongly disagree with the statement that "Ottery St Mary is well connected by bus", particularly since the revised bus timetable came into effect earlier this year which reduced services. The EDDC information also suggests that members of the public can get from Ottery to Exeter Airport directly which is not the case. Appendix 2 contains detailed information on each of the proposed sites and is attached to these minutes.

Otry_1	Barrack Farm, OSM, EX11 1RB	Do not support this site due to concerns regarding flooding, light pollution and noise. Insufficient infrastructure is in place and there are factual errors regarding connectivity.
Council Comments: The Council query the point of 1.25 hectares of employment land at the site when land available at Finnimore Industrial Estate has not been taken up. This application lies in the green wedge between Ottery St Mary and West Hill. The Council do not support this site due to a lack of primary and secondary school places and lack of medical capacity.

Otry_9	Land at Thorne Farm, OSM, EX11 1QZ	Do not support this site due to the visual impact, flooding.

Council comments: It does not make sense that this site is now being supported by EDDC as in January 2020 a planning application on the same site was turned down by EDDC. The Neighbourhood Plan identifies this land should be used for Community and Education use only – not for additional houses. The Council do not support this site.
