



NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER

SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 COUNTY OF DEVON DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL (FOOTPATH No. 64, OTTERY ST MARY) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on June 2023, with no representation or objection having been received, Devon County Council confirmed the above Order as unopposed.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by **adding Footpath No. 64**, **Ottery St Mary** from the end of Ottery St Mary Footpath No. 64, point F on the plan CCET/PROW/22/96, and proceeding in an east south-easterly direction along a sunken lane to meet the recorded unclassified county road, Core Hill Road, at Hollow Head Cross, point G. The total length of the path is approximately 28 metres.
