This Order is made by Devon County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Devon Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) and (iii), namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public footpath, and that other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Devon County Council hereby order that:

- For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2022 1.
- The County of Devon Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described 2. in Parts I and II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Devon County Council (Footpath No. 64, Ottery St Mary) Definitive Map Modification Order 2023.

#### MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

#### DESCRIPTION OF WAY TO BE ADDED

Footpath No. 64, Ottery St Mary

The path is a Footpath. It is situated in the administrative district of East Devon and in the parish of Ottery St Mary. It starts at the end of Ottery St Mary Footpath No. 64, point F (Grid Ref SY 1119 9157) on the plan CCET/PROW/22/96, and proceeds in an east south-easterly direction along a sunken lane to meet the recorded unclassified county road, Core Hill Road, at Hollow Head Cross, point G (Grid Ref SY 1121 9156).

The length of the way to be added is approximately 28 metres with a width of 2-3 metres, as defined by the banks of the sunken lane. It has a surface of earth and stone.

The way is shown on the Order plan as a broken black line between points F-G.

Footpath No. 64, Ottery St Mary

From: East Hill Road

To: The unclassified county road at Hollow Head Cross


The path is a Footpath. It starts at East Hill Road and extends in a south-westerly direction along a rough but well-defined track past a property called Badger's Rest, terminating at the unclassified county road, Core Hill Road, at Hollow Head Cross on the parish boundary. The path has a total length of approximately 400 metres.

The path is a Footpath. It starts at East Hill Road and follows along a track first in a south south-easterly and then a north-easterly direction to meet Footpath No.64 just west of Hollow Head Cross. The path has a total length of approximately 355 metres.
