- It may be necessary for the OMA to disclose information received from you to others, which may include other local authorities, the Planning Inspectorate and other government departments, public bodies, other organisations, landowners and members of the public. If the claim proceeds to a public inquiry your evidence will be made available to the inquiry.
- If the OMA proceeds with the claim but it is contested (for example by a landowner), there may be a public inquiry. This will be held locally and if you are unable to attend your evidence will be given in writing, but user evidence is of much greater value if you attend in person and are prepared to answer questions about it. Inquiries are kept as informal as possible and the OMA will help you with the procedure.
- The information you give in this statement will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation. It is held by the OMA's Rights of Way Service for the sole purpose of processing the claim for the route referred to, and for no other purpose.
