C/25/12/06 VISIT OTTERY

A. To receive an update regarding the Visit Ottery website
The figures for Visit Ottery were reviewed. There has been an increase in the number of interactions on Facebook and Instagram, with significant increases on TikTok.

B. To form a small group to update the Visit Ottery guide
A meeting will be arranged in January to update the guide.

C. To consider any other issues in relation to the Visit Ottery project
Cllr Faithfull highlighted that Visit Ottery leaflets are not in all locations. All Councillors were reminded of the benefit of promoting the project as they travel around the area. The Council engaged Glide to deliver leaflets but currently there are only a small number of 2024 leaflets left. These were distributed to key points. Cllr Faithfull will take the remaining leaflets around to places that he visits.

D. To consider the options regarding Visit Ottery from 1st April 2026
A quote for 2026 was provided. Ignyte have confirmed that as the Visit Ottery site sits on Visit Devon, the Council cannot use an alternative provider due to the access to the Visit Devon DMS/CMS. If the Town Council decide not to continue into 2026/27 the pages will be deleted, and there will be a single page promoting Ottery St Mary as a part of Explore Devon. Cllr Martin will investigate this further. It was noted that the current agreement runs until 31st March 2026.

Cllr Sneller joined the meeting.

Earliest Work Date 01st October 2025
Work Completion Date 30th September 2026
Final submission of Receipts 31st October 2026
