SUSPENSION OF ONE WAY

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL hereby give **NOTICE** that:

From **MONDAY 15 JUNE 2026**
for a maximum of 5 days

Until **THURSDAY 18 JUNE 2026** (both dates inclusive)

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected -
MILL STREET, OTTERY ST MARY
Between 17 and 5A

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - BROAD STREET, SILVER STREET, PATERNOSTER ROW, NORTH STREET, ROAD FROM BUTTS ROAD TO GOSFORD ROAD, ROAD FROM GOSFORD ROAD TO FOUR ELMS FARM, ALFINGTON ROAD, ROAD THROUGH ALFINGTON, ROAD THROUGH FENNY BRIDGES, ROAD FROM PATTESONS CROSS TO BEACON SERVICE STATION, A30, EXETER ROAD, BARRACK ROAD, MILL STREET AND VICE VERSA

The One Way system on the Affected Road will be suspended.

Between 26 Mill Street and Junction of Canaan Way
